<b>Purpose of Course</b>	<p>The purpose of this course is to provide personnel with an awareness of the CASR regulatory framework and of their responsibilities with respect to CASA regulatory requirements for Authorised Maintenance Organisations (AMO).</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> As laid out in 145.A.30 of the EASA and CASR regulations; organisations have to establish and control the competence of personnel involved in any maintenance, development of maintenance programmes, airworthiness reviews, management and/or quality audits. Although this training is not mandatory, initial and continuation training would be required, especially as maintenance organisations are currently transitioning from CAR30 to CASR Part 145</p>
